Addendum No 1 to Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions  
2010 PHRF Winter Series  
January 6, 2010

1. Whereas the stated purpose of the ASC includes promoting sailing and conducting regattas and races and whereas race committees are necessary for sailing regattas and races, ASC promotes the development of competent race committee members. Furthermore ASC considers that participation in the race committee is a way to deepen a members understanding of sailboat racing and that such understanding is beneficial to the whole fleet.
2. Each boats crew will volunteer to act as race committee for one race day in the series with the boat skipper acting as the principal race officer.
3. If there are more boats than races, crews will be combined as necessary to fill the committee needs. After the committee needs are filled remaining boats and crew will be excused from committee participation.
4. Boats participating on race committee will be scored as if they had raced by applying their average score to the race committee day. The average score will be calculated by averaging all other race days excluding each boats two (2) worst races with the fractional averages rounded down.
5. Members participating on race committee will receive work party credits.
6. Preference will be given to skippers who have not served as PRO so as to encourage participation. Bill Collins has agreed to act as PRO adviser/coach on request.
7. Bill Collins will be the scorer.
8. If a skipper fails to complete the assignment of PRO his boat will be scored DNC for that race day.
9. Dan West and the crew of Getting By has volunteered to be race committee for the first race on January 16, 2010.
