



Notice of Race

2011 Halloween Regatta

October 7 - 9, 2011

The organizing authority is the Augusta Sailing Club at Strom Thurmond Lake at Clarks Hill.

Rules: Racing is governed by the US Sailing Association (USSA) RACING RULES OF SAILING (RRS) for 2009-2012, Prescriptions of the USSA, Individual Class Rules and Sailing Instructions (SI available online at augustasailingclub.org and at registration).

Classes: Racing is open to any one-design class boat. Expected Classes include: MC Scow, C Scow, E Scow, SIOD, JY-15, Lightning, J24, J22, PHRF, Laser (Jr & Sr), Moth, Optie (All levels), Sunfish (Jr & Sr). Four boats shall constitute a class.

Scoring: The low point scoring system Rule A-2 will apply modified so that each boat's score shall be the total of their race scores in all races. One race will constitute a regatta.

Fees: See Schedule of Activities and Fees. Register on line by Midnight September 28 and save \$\$\$\$\$. Members of US Sailing will be given a \$5 discount. US Sailing membership cards are required for verification.

Registration: See Schedule of Activities and Fees. A completed registration form and entry fee shall be submitted as part of the registration. Payment is required at the time of registration. By registering all registrants agree that they will be bound by the RRS and all other rules that govern this event.

Schedule: See Schedule of Activities and Fees.

Courses: Courses will be described in the Sailing Instructions and posted on the committee boat.

Prizes: Prizes will be awarded in each Class.

Other: Register on line by Midnight September 28 and save \$\$\$\$ and get the Big Sunday Breakfast too. Register on line by Midnight October 4 and still get the Big Sunday Breakfast free.
